(Stockton Morris Plan v. Carpenter (1936) 18 Cal. App. 2nd 205, 213-214.)

On the Second Cause of Action [identified and articulated in Case # 22STLC08663] in the amount of \$3395.33 [calculated as \$7000 dollars minus \$3700 offset for payments rendered plus prejudgment interest in the amount of \$95.33]. Here, Plaintiff is entitled to prejudgment interest on this cause of action because damages were a liquidated sum and were capable of certain calculation within the meaning of California Civil Code section 3287.
